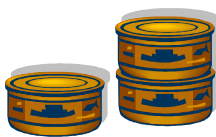
Tournament Time is Here!!!

Our grandchildren now bowl with us in these Adult/Youth tournaments and leagues.

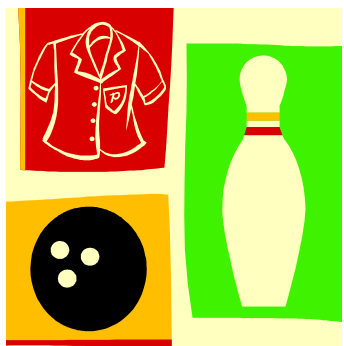
Recently, my daughters, sons-in-law and most of my grandkids bowled with us in the "Strike" Out Breast Cancer tournament. What fun we had!
