

SOUTHEASTERN OHIO USBC  
SCHOLARSHIP (SMART) PROGRAM

The Southeastern Ohio USBC Scholarship has been established to encourage academic achievement and educational advancement and to further the interest in the game of American ten pins through certified bowling competition.

1. \$100.00(each) to be awarded to 2 (two) youth bowlers each year provided the following requirements are met.
2. Applicant must have 3.5 GPA and furnish proof. (Mandatory)
3. Must submit essay form, TOPIC – “What Are Your Goals?”
  - (a) Must be handwritten.
  - (b) Spelling and grammar will be part of judging.
  - (c) 500 words or less
  - (d) Full wording
4. Must apply each year for funds (Ex. If chosen 1<sup>st</sup> year, must reapply 2<sup>nd</sup> year and so on.).
5. Available to 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, grade students.
6. Form must be submitted by FEBRUARY 28<sup>Th</sup>.
7. Participation in youth league and Southeastern Ohio tournament are mandatory.
8. Amount will be held in Smart account until recipient provides proof of university, college, vocational or technical school acceptance.
9. Funds will be paid directly to the school.
10. Scholarships maybe applied toward tuition, room, board, books and/or specialized equipment incidental to higher education.
11. Funds will expire 6 years after high school graduation. (Money will revert to the Scholarship Program.)
12. A committee of 3 will review and evaluate all applications received.
13. Decisions of the committee are final.
14. Any application not meeting any of the above requirements will be ineligible to be judged.
